I am writing to let you know that your child's testing accommodations are all in place and to give you an idea of what the schedule will be like for the next few weeks.

First, if your child has the text-to-speech or speech-to-text accommodations, they will be testing one-on-one in either my room (Mrs. Brown) or in Miss Sandy's speech room. Second, we have also taken care not to schedule testing on Mondays or schedule more than two testing sessions a week.
